I am writing to you on behalf of our HOME Residents Association as I was told you can help with stopping the pruning and pollarding of trees in our roads until winter.

Below you will find a trail of emails - we have lost over 15 trees recently due to unexplained disease or damage by vehicles. Our roads have become extremely busy due to the traffic displacement scheme in Addiscombe West. We are desperate to get more trees and also want to look after the few mature trees we have.
